However, when I received the samples, my excitement temporarily faded. Of the three varieties sent to me, two were flavor combinations I usually would not care for. But the surprise came when I thoroughly enjoyed all three confections!



Maple Cashew Bittersweet Chocolate Crackle

The Maple Cashew Bittersweet Chocolate Crackle was one of my happy little surprises. I generally do not like maple. However, the sweetness of the maple and the cashews is tempered by the flavor of the bittersweet chocolate to create a perfect, decadent treat that I absolutely loved! The thin, crispy Crackle is addictive like potato chips – you can't eat just one piece! The Crackle also comes in flavors like Milk Chocolate & Toasted Hazelnut and Bittersweet Chocolate & Cinnamon Pecan. The Caramel Crackle with Almond & Pistachio sounds like it would be my dream flavor – I will be ordering some soon!



Cherry and Madagascar Vanilla Milk Chocolate Morsels

My other unexpected treat was the Cherry & Madagascar Vanilla Milk Chocolate Morsels. Cherry is not one of my favorite flavors in candy, although I do enjoy fresh cherries. Lucky for me, these confections do not taste like cherry candy, but rather, like fresh cherries scented with vanilla and coated in milk and white chocolate. These little bites are sweet and delicious!



Caramel-Coated Pistachio Milk Chocolate Morsels

I knew I would love the Caramel-Coated Pistachio Milk Chocolate Morsels the second I saw them. The pistachios coated in a crispy caramel shell, enrobed in milk chocolate and dusted with powdered sugar completely satisfied my sweet tooth!
